At this time, the risk of monkeypox to children and adolescents in the United States is low.

A FEW TIPS FOR PREVENTION



Stay Home When Sick

This includes children, staff, and volunteers staying home when sick, ensuring access to adequate handwashing supplies, including soap and water, maintaining routine cleaning and disinfection practices.



Spaces for Assessment

Identifying private spaces for an ill child away from others.



Provide Personal Protective Equipment

Provide personal protective equipment (PPE) for staff who care for students with infectious diseases.



Vaccination

Vaccinations are recommended for high risk groups. Check with your local health care facility to determine if you should be vaccinated.
